### **WorldSkills Career Personality Quiz**

The WorldSkills digital quiz measures and analyses personalities, as well as provides information about jobs that are most interesting for young people to build their career.

The Quiz takes less than 10 minutes. Students can tell us about their skills, what they like to do, and then they can discover jobs which that might interest them and match with their personality and skill sets (current or future). It's a fun quiz which can help your students get to know themselves better and can be shared with friends.

### WorldSkills Ireland 2023 Treasure Hunt

This year, we are running a pilot WorldSkills Ireland 2023 Treasure Hunt. This is a fun way to ensure your students stay engaged, make their way around the entire event and as a bonus, be in with a chance of winning some spot prizes as well as €1,000 for their school. We are giving away €3000 in total to 3 schools, one winner each day. The winning school will be contacted, and an announcement will be made on social media at the end of each day.

#### How it works:

Students can register to participate in the Treasure Hunt before they arrive to WorldSkills Ireland 2023 using their mobile phones. A Registration link can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a> or print out this QR Code (see end of document) for easy registration access. Students can also register when they arrive by scanning QR codes at the event.

Once they arrive to the event, all registered students will receive a SMS to begin the Treasure Hunt!


**Note:** For registration for the Treasure Hunt, students will be asked to enter their phone numbers, select their schools from the drop-down link and to enter their names. All of this information collected during the registration will be deleted once a winner a decided each day. From these questions, we will be able to identify the school in which the winner is from and contact the teacher/guidance counsellor who made the school booking.

There are 5 steps to complete the Treasure Hunt, with each step requiring students to find a 'image icon' in various Zones across the event.

- 1. Competition Zone Pick your Favourite Competition and find the Trophy Image icon at that competition.
- 2. **Heroes Stage** Find the Heroes Stage and locate the Microphone Image Icon
- 3. **#ThisIsFET Zone** Pick your Favourite Competition and find the Trophy Image icon at that competition.
- 4. Educators' Zone Pick your Favourite Competition and find the Trophy Image icon at that competition.
- 5. **Careers' Zone** Pick your Favourite Competition and find the Trophy Image icon at that competition.

Once all 5 steps are done, the Treasure Hunt has been completed and their entry to win the €1000 is submitted automatically!
